Greeting from YFU Thailand office! I hope you all are well.

Recently, I believe you heard the news that Chile suffered a major earthquake and tsunami last weekend. We have two Thai students who are on YFU program now in Chile and both are fine.

We are very fortunate that no current student or family was harmed physically by the recent earthquake. However, there are members of the YFU family in Chile who suffered damages. Although information is still coming in, we know that one former host family lost their entire house, the home of one of our current families incurred catastrophic damage and a volunteer's home had a wall collapse. The YFU Chile Board is setting up a "Solidarity Fund" to collect monetary donations within the country to help YFU volunteers (including host families) who suffered devastating losses and are in need.

As we watch the coverage of the disaster and read the stories, our hearts and thoughts go out to those directly affected. How can we help them?
